About the High Speed Rail Authority

The Australian Government is planning a future high speed rail network to connect Brisbane, Sydney, Canberra, Melbourne and regional communities across the east coast of Australia.

The High Speed Rail Authority (the Authority), an independent corporate Commonwealth entity governed by an independent board, is leading the development and delivery of National High Speed Rail.

Line 1 of this nationally significant project would connect Newcastle to Sydney on a dedicated new railway using trains travelling up to 320km/h.

Journeys would be at least twice as fast as now – it would take about an hour to get from Newcastle to Sydney and about 30 minutes from the Central Coast to Newcastle or to Sydney.

As the proposed network expands, further regions and communities would be connected by high speed rail.

A journey from Canberra to Sydney would take about 90 minutes, while it would take about four hours to travel from Melbourne to Sydney or from Sydney to Brisbane.

The Authority's role includes providing policy and planning advice and recommendations to the Australian Government and undertaking research and evaluation in relation to the high speed rail network and corridor along the east coast.

National High Speed Rail will contribute to a number of key Australian Government priorities, including increased economic productivity, new housing options, regional economic and tourism development and contributing to net zero.

Primary purpose of the role

The purpose of this role during the Development Phase is to take responsibility for embedding compliance obligations into day-to-day operations and providing assurance to senior management, the Board and the Audit and Risk Committee.

Key Responsibilities

This role will be responsible for:

Compliance Framework and Program Management

- Maintain and continuously improve the Authority's legislative compliance framework, ensuring it remains fit for purpose and aligned with legislative, regulatory and policy obligations.
- Oversee the operational compliance program, including the development and maintenance of compliance registers, monitoring activities and reporting mechanisms.
- Ensure appropriate management systems, tools, processes and controls are in place to support effective compliance management and escalation.

Operational Compliance and Business Engagement

- Assist to drive a high compliance culture within the Authority.
- Work closely with internal stakeholders to embed compliance obligations into business processes and day-to-day operations.
- Provide practical guidance and support to the business on compliance requirements and expectations.
- Monitor compliance performance and support the identification, assessment and management of compliance risks.

Breach Management and Reporting

- Oversee the review, assessment and management of compliance breaches, including working with the business to investigate issues and implement remediation actions.
- Maintain breach registers and ensure timely escalation of material matters in accordance with the compliance framework.
- Prepare compliance reports and management attestations, including statements of compliance for senior management and the Audit and Risk Committee.

Assurance and Continuous Improvement

- Support the provision of assurance to senior management and the Audit and Risk Committee, including input into management statements confirming compliance with relevant obligations.
- Identify opportunities for continuous improvement in compliance processes, reporting and controls.
- Contribute to the ongoing development of compliance tools, training and guidance materials.
